AirVenture 2023, America's Aviation Party

The biggest problem that AirVenture has is that it can only be compared to itself. No other aviation event makes plans to accommodate 10,000 airplanes and 650,000 plus attendees. Literally the FAA has its own special building during the event. Only at AirVenture is there disappointment when only one B-29 Bomber attends.

To put things into perspective Disney World averages about 450,00 visitors a week. This year at AirVenture there were 677,000 paid attendances, and AirVenture is principally run with volunteers. This year there were more than 5,500 volunteers who contributed more than 250,000 hours.

AirVenture is an example of the strength of general aviation in the United States. There were more than 1,400 forums, presentations and workshops during the week. More than 10,000 airplanes flew in.

The weather was not as kind as last year, but there was no sever weather. Monday, the start of the show, was warm with good visibility. Mid-week it became hot with limited visibility. On Tuesday FISK arrivals were spaced out, at times to 2 miles. On Wednesday arrivals were spaced out to 5 miles. The poor visibility was a combination of a stagnant air mass and the fires in Canada. There were almost daily rain and thunder storms but they were short and caused no damage

Attendance went up to 677,00 from 650,00 last year. More than 10,000 aircraft attended at Whitman field and at Appleton and Fond du Lac. At Whitman Field there were more than 21,000 operations during the 11 day period from July 20 through July 31. This was also a record year for camping with mor than 13,000 sites, including drive in and fly in. The reach of AirVenture is beyond the airport, more than 18.3 million people were reached through EAA's social media channels.

The highlight of every daily airshow was the

F-22 Demonstration and Heritage Flight Team. This United States AirForce demonstration flight team is based at Langley AFB in Hampton, Virginia. They brought 2, F-22 fighters. and demonstrated them to the max. They were fast, loud, and manurable. While at AirVenture, the very best of aviation show pilots performed in everything from gliders to Beach -18's, the F-22 stole the show every day.

On Monday the Super Guppy arrived making a slightly nose wheel first landing and become the centerpiece of Boeing Square. The Super Guppy is still in use transporting oversized rocket and missile components for NASA. The Super Guppy was originally a Boeing C-97G Stratotanker that first flew in 1953.

The recently restored Lockheed C-121A Constellation, Batan, traveled from Chino, California to AirVenture for its first public appearance since restoration and the first appearance of a Connie at AirVenture since the See "2023" on page 15

Story Of A Female Thunderbird Pilot

This year, EAA AirVenture commemorated 30 years of women flying combat aircraft. The EAA WomenVenture Center in Gateway Park featured exhibitors that support women in aviation and female aviation authors. There was the annual group photo of 1,000+ women in aviation in Boeing Square. Endeavor Air sponsored an Ice Cream Social. There was an evening program in Theater in the Woods with a panel of pioneering women military pi-But spectacular lots. as these were, my favorite this year was the Power Lunch with keynote speaker Michelle "MACE" Curran.

Michelle Curran served

13 years as a fighter pilot in the United States Air Force. From 2019 to 2021 she flew as the only female pilot for the Air Force Thunderbirds. But a little background. Michelle grew up about two hours from Oshkosh in Medford, Wisconsin in a non-aviation, nonmilitary family. She was a self-admitted introvert in high school, and joined the Air Force ROTC program to pay for college. In her sophomore year, they toured an Air Force Base where she was first introduced to F-15 fighter jets. She was hooked.

At first she lacked confidence, but persevered through some mis-steps. For instance, on a training run she was to do a

circle entry at no more than 1G, but went MUCH higher than that, narrowly avoiding a G lock. Hence the MACE callsign her teammates assigned her: "Mach At Circle Entry".

Her first tour of duty was Japan. At just under 6 ft, she stood out in the crowds, and she was miserable. In her Fort Worth assignment, she started out unhappy as a person and as a pilot, but her new unit helped her through. She started saying "yes" to new opportunities. acquired hobbies includnew ing running a marathon and solo trekking in Nepal. She flew missions in Europe, Asia and the



Every night different vendors hosted great parties, I was able to meet lots of interesting pilots from all over the world. I







middle east, as well as seeing combat in Afghanistan. Then she became an instructor pilot. In 2015, Poland asked the Air Force to send them an instructor pilot and Michelle was sent there. She found cultural barriers. The older generation of Polish pilots mainly ignored her, but the younger welcomed her and she eventually found the assignment most rewarding.

In 2019 she began flying with the Thunderbirds. No pressure, but her first public event was the flyover at the Atlanta Superbowl. In the beginning she flew far left in their formations. When she progressed

to solo maneuvers (like vertical rolls) she'd fly at 600 mph, 100 ft above ground. The maneuvers might pull 8 to 9 G's and rise to an altitude of 15.000 ft. In their Delta formation, there may be only 18" separation between **Thunderbird** wingtips. Michelle gave particular credit to the ~130 support people behind the scenes for the Thunderbirds.

Michelle met her husband on the Bumble website. She'd noted that she was a pilot. His response was "Hey, what do you fly?". She replied "F16s". His response: "Huh - I prefer A10s myself." He was a Marine pilot, and they've been married now for four years.

After her military service, she wrote the children's book "Upside Down Dreams" and does a lot of public speaking. She has a major goal of getting more involved in general aviation. She

abashedly claims almost experience flvina "small planes"!

She left the mainly female audience with the thought that there IS a place for you in aviation if you have the courage

to start, say YES to opportunities and learn along the way. The very appreciative audience gave her a standing ova-
















EAA AIRVENTURE OSHKOSH 2023

FACTS AND FIGURES FOR A RECORD-SETTING YEAR

Comment from EAA CEO and Chairman Jack Pelton:

"There was so much going on during the week that encompassed the entire world of flight, from the presence of the U.S. Air Force Training Command and NASA, to magnificent aircraft restorations and exciting new flying technology. Oshkosh was again the place that brought the aviation world together."

Attendance: Approximately 677,000 - A record total (previous mark: 650,000 in 2022). Comment from Pelton:

"We had record-setting totals of campers, exhibitors, volunteers, and more. year at times with weather, logistics, and other factors, which makes me even more proud of the efforts by our volunteers and staff to organize an outstanding event."

Total aircraft: More than 10.000 aircraft arrived at Wittman Regional Airport in

It was also a challenging Oshkosh and other airports in east-central Wisconsin. At Wittman alone, there were 21,883 aircraft operations in the 11-day period from July 20-30, which is an average of approximately 148 takeoffs/landings per hour when the airport is open.

Total showplanes: 3,365

including: A record 1,497 registered in vintage aircraft parking, plus 1,067 homebuilt aircraft, 380 warbirds (up 3 percent from '22), 194 ultralights, 134 seaplanes and amphibians, 52 aerobatic aircraft, and 41 rotorcraft.

Camping: More than 13.000 sites in aircraft and drive-in camping accounted for an estimated 40,000 visitors.

Volunteers: More than 5.500 contributing in excess of 250,000 hours.

Commercial exhibitors: 848 (record number).

Forums, Workshops, and Presentations: More than 1,400 sessions hosted throughout the week.

Social Media, Internet and Mobile: More than 18.3 million people were reached by EAA's social media channels during Air-Venture (up 78 percent over 2022), with engagement of 1.9 million; More than 189,000 hours of viewing EAA video clips online also occurred during the event (more than double the 2022 total).

International guests: International visitors returned in a big way in 2023,

discussed the recently published, Modernization of Special Airworthiness Certification (MOSAIC). MOSAIC redefines the light sport aircraft category by removing the current LSA weight limit of 1,320 pounds and replaced it with a "performancebased" measures such as a 54-knot maximum clean stall speed (Vs1). It was suggested that this will include aircraft such as a Cessna 172 when flown with a pilot and one passenger.

The important change here is that these aircraft will be able to be flown by a Sport Pilot. The medical requirement for a Sport pilot is a valid driver's License, (without any prior medical disqualification.)

It seems that the FAA was making good on its promise made in 2018, when the then Acting Administrator, Mr. Elwell, spoke to the EAA audience about the declining pilot's population and promised the FAA would work to improve access to aviation.

There was a time when the "Meet the Administrator" session always resulted in an overflow crowd. Over the last cou-

ple of years, attendance at the "Meet the Administrator" has substantially declined. Probably this reflects a less adversarial relationship between the FAA and the General Aviation Community.

AirVenture does not operate in a vacuum. The air-

lines were there recruiting as were the aviation orientated universities. Many fine aviation organizations participated in AirVenture.

One of these organizations is Veterans Airlift Command. They serve disables veterans and their families by providing free air transportation for medical and humanitarian needs. This year two members of the Veterans Airlift Command set a Guinness World Record and National Aeronautic Association record by landing their Piper Saratoga in all 48 states in 48 hours. A part of this effort was to raise funds for the

Veterans Airlift Command. Through their efforts they were able to raise over \$43,000 which was presented to the Veterans Airlift Command at Air-Venture.

The actual AirVenture event in Oshkosh was a relatively safe event but sadly there were two fa-

tal accidents. Both occurred on Saturday July 29, 2023. The first was an unexplained crash of a Texan T-6 in Lake Winnebago, resulting in two deaths. The second was a mid-air collision in the ultralight area between a RotorWay Helicopter and a Gyrocopter in the traffic pattern. There were two fatalities and one serious iniury. Both accidents are under investigation by the NTSB.

It is tremendously unfair to all the volunteers and hard workers at AirVenture to give the impression that the airshow is the only activity going on on the field. Showcased on Boeing Squair was a C5-A, the Conne, the Flying Guppy, the B-29 bomber among so may unique aircraft. On Wednesday there was Women's Venture and venders of all types and educational opportunities beyond comprehension.

Special mention must be given to the efforts at Kids Venture. This program which is located near the EAA Museum must be described as a shining gem in the AirVenture crown. They have set up activities to keep hundreds of children individually, engaged and entertained it. There are lots of fans to keep the area cool and the volunteers are beyond spectacular. You can watch children solve electrical problems, practice becoming an air traffic controller, buck and pop rivets. Everywhere you look there are smiles of happy and engaged children.

To be sure EAA was planning AirVenture 2024 before the last plane left Oshkosh following the closing of AirVenture. Next year's show will start July 22, 2024 through July 28, 2024. If you go to the EAA AirVenture website the countdown clock is already running.
